Judge Anderson called meeting this special meeting to Order

Judge Anderson asked the clerk to call roll:

This special meeting opened with the discussion of health insurance for the new fiscal year. Vince Fallis with Roeding Group Companies was the first to present his proposal.

He went over the benefit plan advantage with the court members. The only insurance company that Mr. Fallis proposed was Anthem. He went over how the benefit plan works. Compliance Dashboard provides with the list of compliance duties you must perform, the resources to do so and a repository of completed tasks that can be accessed in the event of an audit. The rates you pay also are inclusive of this invaluable resource. Anthem Blue View Vision is an integral part of the medical plan at no additional cost. An Association Dental Plan that has no waiting periods for any type of services and that had no rate adjustment entering its second year. Services for completion and filing of RS forms 1094 and 1095 are available for an extra cost. He gave court members a copy of the medical and dental plans available along with the costs. Josie Hollon with Elkins Insurance was the next person to a proposal for health insurance.

Mr. Hollon has been a dependent insurance agent for over 40 years with Elkins Insurance and is also the counties current agent. She told members in order to offer more options to her customers; she has affiliated her agency with Agent-link, a placement service for most health and life insurance companies in the state. This allows her to offer the services of all major insurance companies to a much smaller clientele base than they usually cater too and a competitive rate. The best insurance coverage as the best price that we can get for Powell County Fiscal Court is with Humana and the savings are at least 50% of what you are paying now due to various underwriting regulations. The life insurance is almost half the price of UHC. The dental with Humana has also dropped by #3.56 per individual and Humana has agreed to the continued coverage so employees will not have to wait another year for the dental

work they need nw. The vision is .32 to \$1.30 increase difference from UHC but if the court takes 2 ancillary products with Humana they will give another 2% discount. (Copy will follow minutes)

He gave court members a revised list of the packages that he proposed during last month's meeting.

Package A – Offers the best overall package premium

Package B - Simplified Billing, One ID card for all coverage's and discounted medical rates.

Package C – Offers the best overall carrier Package, Second only to revised package A.
